The original should be received by us no later than 28 February 2006. It is important that this date is adhered to as we are working within a tight schedule to ensure that the book is published to a very high standard in time for the Conference. You should also include an PC diskette containing your paper.

When sending the manuscript, please complete and return the following:

- * Registration form
- * Publishing Agreement
- * Specially reduced author's registration fee which is required before processing can commence.

Papers in excess of 10 pages will be charged at £35.00 per extra page to support additional printing costs and this amount should accompany your paper.

If your paper is not accepted, your payment will be refunded to you, should you decide not to attend the conference. Please note that, in order to be fair to all participants, <u>each delegate can only present one paper</u>.

Notification of the acceptance of your paper will be given in due course and the manuscript will then be sent for publication providing everything is in order. The Publisher will contact you if there are any editorial changes to be made.

We look forward to receiving your paper and meeting you in London.
